Individual are regarded as smokers if they described themselves as "current cigarette smokers" in the Health Survey for England.</p>
Binge Drinking	<p>Source: Association of Public Health Observatories - Estimates of Adults' Health and Lifestyles</p> <p>The estimated percentage of the population aged 16+ that binge drink. Binge drinking in adults is defined separately for men and women. Men are defined as having indulged in binge drinking if they had consumed 8 or more units of alcohol on the heaviest drinking day in the previous seven days; for women the cut-off was 6 or more units of alcohol.</p>
Healthy Eating	<p>Source: Association of Public Health Observatories - Estimates of Adults' Health and Lifestyles</p> <p>The estimated percentage of the population aged 16+ that eat healthily. Healthy eating is defined as those who consume 5 or more portions of fruit and vegetables per day. A portion of fruit or vegetables was defined as an 80g serving.</p>
